



ABSTRACT OF LABORATORY AND CLINICAL STUDIES

TREATING VARIOUS SKIN DISEASES WITH A WET DRESSING

This study of the effect of Yin-Care on various skin conditions was carried out between May 1991 and April 1992 at the Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital.

The total study consisted of 687 patients with 13 kinds of skin disorders. The Yin-Care group was made up of 587 test subjects. These patients were treated with a 3% Yin-Care solution applied as a wet dressing four times daily.

Two control groups were also set up and were comprised of a total of 100 test subjects. One group of these patients were treated with a 3% boric acid solution. The other control group was treated with .02 % furacin solution. These two medicinal solutions were applied as a wet dressing four times daily. (See chart)

Of the total 587 patients in the Yin-Care group, 33.5 cases were completely cured. And of those remaining, Yin-Care was very effective in 209 cases, effective in 38 cases, and ineffective in 38 cases. Total effectiveness rate was 93.5%.
